Click will automate the submission, review, and approval processes while managing major administrative aspects of the research and compliance lifecycle:


- Proposal development and submission



Grants Module


Provides an electronic system for the management of proposal submissions and budgets along with an award component that will compliment the Oracle Business System. Replaces the ESPS (approval form)

- Provides the ability to submit Grants.Gov applications through Click as a system to system transaction leveraging data entered in the forms to reduce duplicate entries
- Will provide proposal Team members (Co-Investigators; administrative staff; and SPS) access to the application for review and input.




Grants Module
