





What is a Micro-Credential?

Micro-credentials showcase the knowledge you've acquired on the road to mastering skills in your area of interest. Smaller than a minor, certificate or degree program, micro-credentials equip learners with digital badges that showcase their achievements and all it took to get there.

Skills you need. Proof you have them.



What is a Digital Badge?


A digital icon that represents the successful completion of a learning experience.

Badges are clickable and contain metadata, including:

- Information regarding the issuing institution.
- Date earned.
- Criteria required to earn the badge.
- Evidence that shows you have met the required criteria.


Digital badges are dynamic credentials that **you** own, so you can decide how you want to use them. Once you earn a badge you own it, so you may use it however you wish. Digital badges can be shared on LinkedIn, added as a link on your digital resume, displayed in your email signature and more.

- Display badges that contain your achievements and competencies to employers, colleagues and peers.






