Focus Area: Scholarly Publishing

- October 2: What Journals Editors Want
- October 9: Choosing the Correct Journal Impact Metrics, Predatory Publishers
- October 16: Creating one standard author name using ORCID, tracking your citations, and automating updates from journals in your field
- October 23: Create your UB research and publishing ePortfolio

End of month deliverables: ORCID id created, research statement uploaded to your ePortfolio, reflection post related to publishing/research goals

Focus Area: Data/Copyright Issues

- October 30: How to Comply with IRB Policies at UB
- November 6: Copyright & Scholarly Publishing
- **November 13**: Creating and Maintaining a Data Management Plan
- **November 20**: Write up a data management plan, begin an IRB protocol, or work on a publication or grant draft

End of month deliverables: Data management plan uploaded to your ePortfolio for a project you are either currently working on or intend to pursue. Reflection post on IRB process or Copyright policies/processes.

Focus Area: Preparing Your Manuscript/Grant

- **December 4:** What Grant Reviewers are looking for in a compelling submission
- **December 11:** Mechanics of Scholarly Writing (perspectives from seasoned authors)
- **December 18:** Revise your research statement to include what you have been working on this academic year, include what grants you might pursue and what publishers or conferences you might submit abstracts. Wrap up and discussion of NFA Spring Showcase projects.

End of month deliverables: Revised research statement uploaded to your ePortfolio and a reflective post on what supports you need to achieve your publishing/research goals for the NFA spring showcase.
